









Do you know **Where to Go** when your child is unwell?

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cough, runny nose, sore throat • Fever in children above 3 months old • Fever of less than 5 days • Ear pain • Mild vomiting and diarrhoea • Fussy baby • Sprains or strains • Constipation • Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease • Minor cuts and wounds • Medical condition for clearance and reviews 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Worsening fever in children between 3 months to 1 year old • Prolonged fever for more than 5 days • Persistent vomiting • Minor asthma or wheeze • Fractures or broken bones that are not crooked • Minor cuts or wounds • Minor burns • Moderate allergies    	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shortness of breath • Blue or purple lips, skin or fingernails • Chest pain • Severe stomach pain • Uncontrolled pain • Seizures • Animal or human bites • Severe bleeding or burns • Head/spinal cord injuries • Fever in children below 3 months old • Severe allergic reactions • Poisoning • Suicidal thoughts or attempts
