Case Management Officers (CMOs) are trained mental health professionals who work with our doctors and psychologists to help you recover!



WHAT DO CASE MANAGEMENT OFFICERS DO?



1 CRISIS MANAGEMENT

- CMOs provide timely phone and face-to-face assessments and intervention.
- They can accompany you to your doctor and psychologist appointments to provide emotional support during your consultation.

2 LIAISON

- CMOs help to liaise with your care team to facilitate your recovery!
 - o Schools
 - Parents
 - Psychiatrists
 - Psychologists
 - Community partners



 They can explore and link you up with community programmes where you can spend your time meaningfully.



3 EMOTIONAL SUPPORT FOR YOUTHS

 CMOs are contactable via phone calls or texts in between your doctor and therapy appointments.





 They are equipped to guide you in adopting a healthy lifestyle, teach you coping skills and support you in times of distress.

4 EMOTIONAL SUPPORT FOR PARENTS

 CMOs also work with parents to help them understand your needs, develop strategies to support you in your recovery and also connecting them to additional parenting support.
